

This marks the sixth time that a triennial conference has been presented to the public by the Institute for Redemptorist Historical Studies of North America.

On the first full day of the conference (Tuesday) we will feature talks about two Redemptorist who used television and radio as a means of preaching; Rev. Joseph Manton, C.Ss.R. (1904-1998) and Rev. Matthew Meehan, C.Ss.R. (1913-1998)

Wednesday's topics will highlight several Redemptorist scholars and teachers: Rev. Francis X. Murphy, C.Ss.R. (1914-2002), patristic scholar and peritus at Vatican II; Rev. Francis Connell, C.Ss.R. (1888-1967), moral theologian and Vatican II peritus; and Rev. Louis Hartman, C.Ss.R. (1901-1970), scripture scholar and Editor-in-Chief for the 1970 edition of the New American Bible.

The final full day (Thursday) will focus on the promotion of Healing and Consolation in association with North American Redemptorist Shrines and devotional practices. The morning will be spent with the noted scholar, Kathleen Sprows-Cummings, Ph.D, who will talk about the dynamics of devotion to St.



John Neumann. The afternoon will focus on Redemptorist ministry and the people's experience at the holy sites of St. Anne de Beaupre in Quebec, and Mission Church in Boston.
