

This marks the seventh time that a triennial conference has been presented to the public by the Institute for Redemptorist Historical Studies of North America. The Conference theme this year will be "Redemptorists at the Margins."

On the first full day of the conference (Wednesday) we will feature a presentation by Dr. Paul Laverdure, Ph.D., on Fr. Alphonse Hendrickx and his ministry in 19th century Quebec, New Brunswick, & the Northern United States. The afternoon session will feature a presentation about Redemptorists and the International Catholic Deaf Association by Dr. Marlana Portolano of Towson University.

Thursday's morning session will highlight the life and legacy of Venerable Alfred Pampalon. The afternoon session will be devoted to a joint presentation on Redemptorists and orphanages.

Two presenters are scheduled: Fr. Gil Enderle, CSSR, will discuss the orphanages organized by Redemptorists in the Southern United States while Patrick Hayes, Ph.D., will survey the Congregation's involvement with orphans in Pittsburgh, Baltimore, and New York. Father Matt Allman will discuss the Redemptorist mission in Puerto Rico.

A special feature of this conference will be the opportunity to tour the Shrine and Museum.
